

Examples of essay tasks for the 'Conflict' Poetry Cluster.

Compare 'A Poison Tree' and another poem from the Conflict Cluster where the speaker is unhappy.

Compare 'The Destruction of Sennacherib' and another poem from the Conflict Cluster where the conflict is set in war time.

Compare 'Extract from the Prelude' and another poem from the Conflict Cluster where the speaker expresses their feelings.

Compare 'The man he killed' and another poem from the Conflict Cluster where we are shown the effects of war.

Compare 'Cousin Kate' and another poem from the Conflict Cluster where negative emotions are expressed.

Compare 'Half Caste' and another poem from the Conflict Cluster where views about racial identity are expressed.

Compare 'Exposure' and another poem from the Conflict Cluster conflict leads to misunderstanding.

Compare 'The Charge of the Light Brigade' and another poem from the Conflict Cluster which captures the tragedy of war.

Compare 'Catrin' and another poem from the Conflict Cluster which presents conflict on a smaller scale.

Compare 'War Photographer' and another poem from the Conflict Cluster which explores how conflicts create divisions between people.

Compare 'Belfast Confetti' and another poem from the Conflict Cluster that explores feelings of confusion.

Compare 'The Class Game' and another poem from the Conflict Cluster which explores personal identity.

Compare 'Poppies' and another poem from the Conflict Cluster which shows the way war is destructive.

Compare 'No problem' and another poem from the Conflict Cluster where the conflict causes personal anxiety.

Compare 'What Were they Like' and another poem from the Conflict Cluster where there is a sense of loss.
